



BOO BITTLE HAPPY

WHAT YOU NEED

MATERIALS

Light grey cotton yarn

A pair of safety eyes, 6 mm Stuffing Crochet hook, size 2.5 mm Blush for the cheeks

ABBREVIATIONS

Stitch (sts)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Chain stitch (ch)
Single crochet (sc)
decrease (2→1)
Increase (2i1)
Round (R)

BOO will measure approx. 10 cm in height.

LITTLE HAPPY

BODA

· light grey yarn

Stuff as you go!

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R4: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R5: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R6: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R7: (5 sc, 2i1) \times 6 = 42 sts

R8: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 48 \text{ sts}$

R9-26: sc around = 48 sts

Insert your safety eyes at this point. Place them between round 12 and 13 with a 5-sc gap between them.

R27: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R28: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R29: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R30: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R31: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R32: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R33: $(2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 6 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.

EARS (MAKE 2)

· light grey yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 3 = 9 \text{ sts}$

R3-5: sc around = 9 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the ears to the head.

Fold the ears flat and sew them to each side of the head making them bend a bit.

ARMS AND LEGS (MAKE 4)

· light grey yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3-4: sc around = 12 sts

R5: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 4 = 8 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the arms and legs to the body.

Sew the arms to each side of the body, 17 rounds below the top of head.

Sew the legs to the bottom, approx. in round 29. Make sure that BOO can stand before sewing.

Put some blush on the cheeks.



LITTLE HAPPY PINKY

WHAT YOU NEED

MATERIALS

Light pink cotton yarn A small amount of pink cotton yarn A small amount of white cotton yarn

A pair of safety eyes, 6 mm Stuffing Crochet hook, size 2.5 m

ABBREVIATIONS

Stitch (sts)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Chain stitch (ch)
Single crochet (sc)
decrease (2→1)
Increase (2i1)
Round (R)

Pinky will measure approx. 10 cm in height.

LÍTTLE HAPPY PINKY

BODA

· light pink yarn

Stuff as you go!

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R4: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R5: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R6: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R7: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R8: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 48 \text{ sts}$

R9-26: sc around = 48 sts

Insert your safety eyes at this point. Place them between round 10 and 11 with a 6-sc gap between them.

R27: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R28: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R29: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R30: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R31: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R32: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R33: $(2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 6 \text{ m}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.

NOSE

· pink yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R4: in the back loop only, sc around

= 18 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the nose to the head.

EARS (MAKE 2)

· light pink yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: sc around = 6 sts

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 3 = 9 \text{ sts}$

R4: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 3 = 12 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the ears to the head.

Sew the ears to the head making them bend a bit.

ARMS AND LEGS (MAKE 4)

· light pink yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3-4: sc around = 12 sts

R5: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 4 = 8 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the arms and legs to the body.

Sew the arms to each side of the body, approx. on round 17. Sew the legs to the bottom of the body, approx. on round 29. Make sure that pinky can stand before sewing.

Embroider 2 white lines on the nose.



LITTLE HAPPY BIRDY

WHAT YOU NEED

MATERIALS

Blue cotton yarn A small amount of curry yellow cotton yarn

A pair of safety eyes, 6 mm Stuffing Crochet hook, size 2.5 m

ABBREVIATIONS

Stitch (sts)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Chain stitch (ch)
Single crochet (sc)
decrease (2→1)
Increase (2i1)
Round (R)

Birdy will measure approx. 10 cm in height.

BODA

· blue yarn

Stuff as you go!

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R4: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R5: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R6: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

D7- (F -- 2:1) -- (42 -+-

R7: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R8: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 48 \text{ sts}$

R9-26: sc around = 48 sts

Insert your safety eyes at this point. Place them between round 10 and 11 with a 6-sc gap between them.

R27: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R28: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R29: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R33: $(2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 6 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.

ARMS AND LEGS (MAKE 4)

· blue yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3-4: sc around = 12 sts

R5: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 4 = 8 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the arms and legs to the body.

BEAK

· curry yellow yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: sc around = 6 sts

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 9 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the beak to the head.

Sew the beak to the head, just below the eyes.

Sew the arms to each side

Sew the arms to each side of the body, approx. on round 17. Sew the legs to the bottom of the body, approx. on round 29. Make sure that Birdy can stand before sewing.



LITTLE HAPPY PANDA

WHAT YOU NEED

MATERIALS

White cotton yarn Black cotton yarn

Stuffing Crochet hook, size 2.5 m

ABBREVIATIONS

Stitch (sts)
Slip stitch (sl st)
Chain stitch (ch)
Single crochet (sc)
decrease (2→1)
Increase (2i1)
Round (R)

Panda will measure approx. 10 cm in height.

BODA

· white yarn

Stuff as you go!

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R4: $(2 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R5: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R6: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

NO. (4 SC, 211) X 0 = 30 StS

R7: (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts **R8:** (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts

R9-26: sc around = 48 sts

R27: $(6 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 42 \text{ sts}$

R28: $(5 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 36 \text{ sts}$

R20. (3 3c, 2 71) x 0 = 30 3cs

R29: $(4 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 30 \text{ sts}$

R30: $(3 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 24 \text{ sts}$

R31: $(2 \text{ sc, } 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 18 \text{ sts}$

R32: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R33: $(2 \rightarrow 1) \times 6 = 6 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.

EYES (MAKE 2)

· black yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3: 3 hstgm = 3 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the eyes to the head.

EARS (MAKE 2)

· black yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2i1) \times 3 = 9 \text{ sts}$

R3-4: sc around = 9 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the ears to the head.

Sew them on to each side of the head.

ARMS AND LEGS (MAKE 4)

· black yarn

R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

R2: $(2i1) \times 6 = 12 \text{ sts}$

R3-4: sc around = 12 sts

R5: $(1 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \times 4 = 8 \text{ sts}$

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to sew the arms and legs to the body.

Sew the arms to each side of the body, approx. on round 17. Sew the legs to the bottom of the body, approx. on round 29. Make sure that Panda can stand before sewing.

Embroider 2 white spots in each eye.
