# LITTLE HAPPY CROCHET CAL

## WHAT YOU NEED

### **MATERIALS**

80 g of brown cotton yarn  
- Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color  
07 Cigar

20 g of white cotton yarn  
- Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color  
01 White

A small amount of light pink cotton  
yarn  
- Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color  
045 Blossom

A small amount of beige cotton  
yarn  
- Must-Have, color 09 Limestone

A small amount of mint green  
cotton yarn  
- Must-Have, color 073 Jade Gravel

A small amount of petrol blue  
cotton yarn  
- Must-Have, color 069 Petrol blue

A pair of safety eyes, 8 mm  
Stuffing  
Crochet hook, size 2.5 mm  
Optional, a piece of thick steel wire

# PART 1

## PART A

### • brown yarn

*Stuff as you go!*

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R6:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R7:** (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R8:** (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts

**R9:** (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts

**R10:** (8 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 60 sts

**R11:** (9 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 66 sts

**R12-23:** sc around = 66 sts

**R24:** (9 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 60 sts

**R25:** sc around = 60 sts

**R26:** (8 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 54 sts

**R27:** sc around = 54 sts

**R28:** (7 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 48 sts

**R29:** sc around = 48 sts

**R30:** (6 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R31-32:** sc around = 42 sts

**R33:** (5 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R34-35:** sc around = 36 sts

**R36:** (4 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R37-38:** sc around = 30 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

# PART 2

## PART B

### • **brown yarn**

*Stuff as you go!*

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R6:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R7:** (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R8:** (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts

**R9:** (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts

**R10:** (8 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 60 sts

**R11:** (9 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 66 sts

**R12:** (10 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 72 sts

**R13-24:** sc around = 72 sts

Insert your safety eyes at this point. Place them between round 14 and 15 with a 17-gap between them

**R25:** (10 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 66 sts

**R26:** (9 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 60 sts

**R27:** (8 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 54 sts

**R28:** (7 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 48 sts

**R29:** (6 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R30:** (5 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R31:** (4 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 30 sts

Finish with a slip stitch and break the yarn.

# PART 3

## PART C (MAKE 2)

### • brown yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (2 sc sc, 2i1) x 4 = 16 sts

**R4-8:** sc around = 16 sts

**R9:** (6 sc sc, 2→1) x 2 = 14 sts

**R10-24:** sc around = 14 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

## PART D (MAKE 2)

### • brown yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** (3 sc sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R6:** (4 sc sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R7-10:** sc around = 36 sts

**R11:** (2→1) x 3, 30 sc sc = 33 sts

**R12:** (2→1) x 3, 27 sc sc = 30 sts

**R13:** (2→1) x 3, 24 sc sc = 27 sts

**R14:** (2→1) x 3, 21 sc sc = 24 sts

**R15-17:** sc around = 24 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

# PART 4

## PART E

### • beige yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R6:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R7:** (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R8:** (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts

**R9:** (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

## PART F (MAKE 2)

### • brown yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R6:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R7:** (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts

**R8-14:** sc around = 42 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

## PART G

### • white yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 3 = 9 sts

**R3-40:** sc around = 9 sts

**R41:** (1 sc, 2→1) x 3 = 6 sts

Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

If you choose to use steel wire, bend a piece of steel wire double the length of part G and insert it in the part before closing the hole. See picture below.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.

# PART 5

## PART H (MAKE 2)

### • white yarn

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 3 = 9 sts

**R3:** sc around = 9 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 3 = 12 sts

**R5:** sc around = 12 sts

**R6:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R7-8:** sc around = 18 sts

**R9:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R10-21:** sc around = 24 sts

**R22:** (2 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R23:** sc around = 18 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

## PART I (MAKE 2)

### • light pink yarn

This part is crocheted in rows.

Turn each row with a chain stitch.

Chain 4. Start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from the hook.

**Rw1:** sc around = 3 sts

**Rw2:** 2i1, 1 sc, 2i1 = 5 sts

**Rw3-13:** sc around = 5 sts

Crochet 1 sc all the way around part I.

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembly.

## PART J

### • ice blue yarn

Stuff as you go!

**R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts

**R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R5:** sc around = 24 sts

**R6:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R7:** sc around = 30 sts

**R8:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts

**R9-12:** sc around = 36 sts

Change to petrol blue

**R13-15:** sc around = 36 sts

Change to ice blue yarn

**R16-19:** sc around = 36 sts

**R20:** (4 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 30 sts

**R21:** (3 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 24 sts

**R22:** (2 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 18 sts

**R23:** (1 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 12 sts

**R24:** (2→1) x 6 = 6 sts

Finish with a slip stitch. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail to close the hole.

Close the hole by stitching through the front loops of the last 6 stitches. Pull the thread so the hole closes in. Weave in ends.





# ASSEMBLY

1.

Pin part E (the nose) on to the head to make sure it doesn't move while sewing. Place the nose 11 rounds from the top and sew it on.



2.

Sew part B (the head) and part A (the body) together. Stuff the neck before sewing all the way around to stabilize the head.



3.

Pin part F (the ears) to each side of the head and sew them on. Place the ears between part 5 and 25.



4.

Stuff part C (the arms) but now all the way to the top. Sew the arms to each side of the body, 2 rounds below the neck.



5.

Stuff part D (the legs).  
Pin the legs to the body with approx. 8 sc  
between them.  
Make sure that the bear can sit properly  
before sewing.



6.

Sew part I (the inside of the bunny ears)  
onto part H (the bunny ears).  
Sew the bunny ears onto part G (the  
headband) with 5 rounds between them.



7.

Form part G (the hairband) around the  
bears head if you have chosen to use steel  
wire.  
If you have chosen not to use steel wire,  
pin the hairband to the bears head and  
sew it on.



8.

Embroider the white spots on part J (the  
Easter egg).  
I have sewn 6 spots on the petrol blue line  
on the egg.
